Competition: *PLEASE NOTE NEW CRITERIA FOR 2018

Entrants may choose from the following Divisions:

Open Championship Division

*Open to ages 12-17

***Must have verifiable GHIN handicap index of 10.0 or less**

*Must declare to play in this division when entering

* 36-holes Stroke Play (18 holes per day)

* Yardage will be approximately 6000 yards per round

Flighted Age Division

*Open to ages 12-17

*** Must have handicap of 27 or less or average score no greater than 100/18**

holes

* Flighted by age (12-13, 14-15, 16-17)

* 36-holes Stroke play (18 holes per day)

* Yardage will be approximately 5200 yards per round

* Players in this Division are not eligible to win the Championship Trophy

Pace of Play will be enforced

Prizes: Champion - Winner's trophy and custody of the championship trophy for one year **Ties**-See Local Rules. **There will be a Long Drive and Putting Contests during play on Tuesday. Championship Flight:** 1st-4th place **Age Flights:** 1st-4th place. **Ties**- See Local Rules

Range Balls: Complimentary each day prior to play and Practice Round.

Starting Times: Pairings for Tues, June 26th will be emailed and posted on the WOGA website by Saturday, June 23, 12PM. **It is the player's responsibility to obtain and verify their own tee times.** Players will be re-paired for Weds. round. Pairings will be emailed and posted on the WOGA website following completion of Tues. play.

Lunch: WOGA will provide **each player** with a cold cut buffet on Tues. and a hamburger buffet on Weds. immediately following play. Others may pay cash on availability.

Caddies: A player may provide her own caddie. **A player may not use a parent, guardian, step-parent as a caddie.** Players or caddies may **NOT** use automotive transportation during tournament play. **Exception:** See Local Rules

Spectators: Players shall not seek or accept any advice during the round. Parents or gallery may not walk or ride along side golfers and must stay at least 15 yards away from all junior golfers during the round. Spectator carts will be limited to the cart paths/rough and are subject to availability \$30/cart. The course/WOGA may request spectators to share a cart.

Dress Code: A dress code will be strictly enforced on the golf course. WOGA participants, their families, guest and spectators must wear appropriate attire. Traditional golf shirts, slacks, skirts and shorts are acceptable. **No blue jeans or denims may be worn. No tank tops or halter tops.** Collarless golf shirts are allowed.
