Competition: Nine -Hole Division

- * Open to ages 8-11
- * Flighted by age (8-9, 10-11)
- * 18-holes Stroke Play (9 holes per day)
- * Yardage will be approximately 2000 yards per round

Pace of Play will be enforced.

Prizes: Winner 9 Hole: custody of the traveling trophy for one year.

There will be Long Drive and Putting Contests during play on Tuesday.

Open Championship Division

*Open to ages 12-18

***Must have verifiable GHIN handicap index of 10.0 or less**

*Must declare to play in this division when entering

* 36-holes Stroke Play (18 holes per day)

* Yardage will be approximately 6000 yards per round

Flighted Age Division

*Open to ages 12-18

*** Must have handicap of 27 or less or average score no greater than 100/18**

* Flighted by age (12-13, 14-15, 16-18)

* 36-holes Stroke play (18 holes per day)

* Yardage will be approximately 5200 yards per round

* Players in this Division are not eligible to win the Championship Trophy

Pace of Play will be enforced
